SAFETY FLASH: GOOD HOUSEKEEPING

GOOD PRACTICE

- ✔ Working area is clean and tidy (deck, engine room)
- ✔ Electricity cupboards are free from materials
- ✔ Stairs and (emergency) exits are clean and free from obstacles
- ✔ Storing used rags or cloths in closed steel bins/buckets
- ✔ Oil leakages are fixed immediately
- ✔ Storing materials and tools in appropriate way
- ✔ Keeping paint in closed drums and stored



Obstacles, clutter and materials laying around on deck and engine rooms could lead to incidents/accidents. The fundament for safe working is good housekeeping!



BAD PRACTICE

- ✘ Clutter, dirt and materials lying around on deck and in engine rooms
- ✘ Ignoring oil leakages
- ✘ Keeping paint open in drums in the working area
- ✘ Obstacles on and/or nearby stairs and (emergency) exits
